8:00 a.m.—7:00 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday Please observe pool swimming hours!



We are <u>CLOSED MONDAYS</u> so that we can shock the pool and for maintenance. People who break the rules and swim after swimming hours risk injury and may be subject to a fine and expulsion from the pool for a week, month, or the rest of the swimming season.

MEMBERS and their GUESTS <u>MUST</u> check in at the Pro Shop for pool and pool house access if the Pool House is not open. Remember to obey all pool rules.

The pool rules are printed below, as well as in the pool house.

BRENHAM COUNTRY CLUB SWIMMING POOL RULES

WARNING: There is no lifeguard on duty! Swim at your own risk! Children should not use pool without adult supervision.

All members and guests must check in with the Brenham Country Club staff prior to pool entry.

All persons must shower prior to pool entry.

Glass containers prohibited.

No person shall eat or drink, while in the pool; and, no smoking in the pool area.

No running or horseplay allowed.

Proper swim attire required.

No pets allowed.

No alcoholic beverages allowed from outside Brenham Country Club.

Club staff will strictly enforce pool rules. Club staff decisions are final.

Any rule violation may lead to expulsion from the pool and club. Breaking the pool rules and swimming after hours is an injury risk and may be subject to a fine and expulsion from the pool for a week, month, ore the rest of the swimming season.
